Dress Code Policy

Shirts

Any solid color polo shirt.

Let your child choose a their favorite colors!

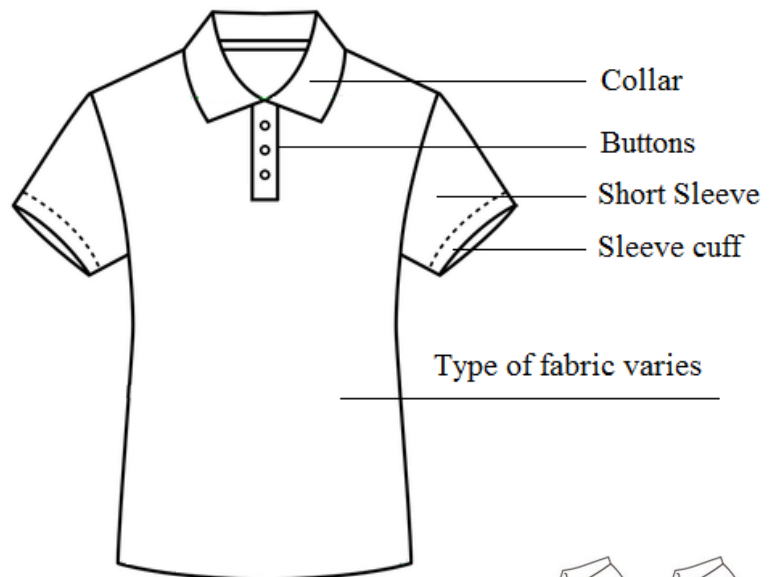


Polo shirts must be a completely solid colored polo shirt with no writing or designs.

When purchasing your shirt, please make sure the tag states "Polo" as Polo shirts have a specific design:

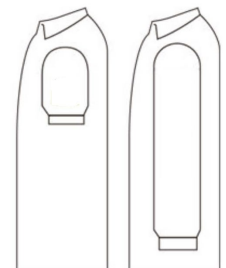
Fabric type will vary

Polo shirts are made in various types of fabrics including: cotton blends, synthetic materials or performance fabric with stretch features. Choose the most comfortable fabric for your child(ren).



Polo Sleeve length

Polo shirts come in short sleeve and long sleeve versions, both are acceptable to use at Co-op.



Note: a small logo no larger than approximately 3 inches square is acceptable.

Pants and Shorts



Both boys and girls are allowed to wear solid colored Khaki or Navy pants or shorts.

- Pants should be a "straight leg" style, no skinny or baggy styled pants.
- No cargo style shorts or pants and no side-leg pockets.
- No joggers.
- Capri pants are not allowed.
- Pants or shorts may have a front button or snap and zipper with belt loops.
- Drawstring or pull on style is acceptable for sensory sensitive students.
- Fabric may quick dry, twill, cotton blends, synthetic materials or performance fabric.



Pants and Shorts must be worn at the natural waistline or with a belt if needed to keep them there.



Skirts

For girls only: solid colored Khaki or Navy skirts are allowed.

The style of the skirt will vary but guideline for skirts should be "uniform style" no tight fitting skirts. Similar to these shown.

Skirts must come to the knee when sitting, standing, or walking. Slits must be no higher than knee length.



Skirt style should be similar to these shown.

Dresses

For girls only: any solid colored "uniform styled" Tennis or Polo dress.

- While there are many "polo" and "tennis" style dresses, guideline for dresses should be "uniform style."
- No tight fitting dresses.
- No lace, emblems, logos or designs.

Dress style should be similar to these shown.

Dresses must come to the knee when sitting, standing, or walking. Slits must be no higher than knee length.



Socks Socks must be solid colored white, black, navy, khaki or gray.

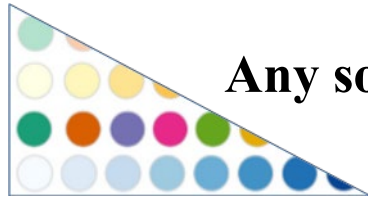


Accessories

Accessories (jewelry, belt buckles, hats, hair accessories, bags etc.) may not have inappropriate symbols or writing on them (e.g., Gothic or rock band symbols).

Belts, if needed, should be any shade tan, brown or black.





Any solid color sweatshirt.

Let your child choose a their favorite colors!

Outerwear, such as a sweater, worn during the co-op day must be solid colored with no writing and worn in the way it was intended.

Note: a small logo no larger than approximately 3 inches square is acceptable.



Sweatshirts may be worn any time of the year, but hoods should not be used indoors.

Shoes

Athletic shoes as well as closed toe sandals are allowed. For safety, no flip flops, slides, open-back sandals, slippers, Heelys or Croc style shoes.
